

Online AMI 0-3 Assistants Certificate Course

International Certificate Course for Assistants in a Montessori Infant and Toddler Community.

Goal of the Course: The intention of the international AMI Assistants Certificate Course is to help interested adults become able assistants in a Montessori Infant and Toddler Community. In a Montessori classroom, the assistant supports the lead teacher and helps him/her to create and retain balance. He/she observes children and knows when to intervene and when to withhold from helping. He/she knows how to support children in developing independence and has a deep understanding of Montessori's approach to freedom and discipline. He/she is a great supporter for the lead teacher and for the child.

Trainer: Heidi Philippart, Netherlands, AMI 0-3 Trainer.

Duration: Approximately 48 hours of lectures and independent work. 9 additional hours of obligatory observations. Specific instructions on how to observe will be given during the Course, taking into account the restrictions which may be imposed by Covid 19.

Daily Schedule: The course hours are given in Central European Time. For a detailed course schedule check out the Course Schedule document.

Course language:

- English, with interpretation of the spoken word to Czech and other languages announced on the website. Students need to have an adequate level of understanding of English, Czech other languages of the course, to succeed in the course.
- Written coursework, the written assignments, can be done in English, Czech and other announced languages.
- If there is interest, the possibility of interpretation into other languages, other than already announced, can be consulted with the Course Director.

Obligatory reading: Selected reading from Understanding the Human Being, The Child in the Family, Education for a New World, 1946 Lectures and The Absorbent Mind will be done during the Course.

Requirements for Certification: Submission of three papers (500 words) on topics set by the Trainer during the period of the Course. 9 hours of obligatory observation. Submission of observation notes and observation report. Submission of any other Course work assigned by the Trainer. Submission of handmade materials - mobiles and language cards. Submission of a video of the three period lesson. Minimum of 90% attendance. More information about requirements for certification will be given at the beginning of the Course.
